Initiative created by the association “Seeds of Solidarity”

Alchemy of consumption

The association “Seeds of solidarity” was founded in April 2019 and has the aim of raising awareness and of encouraging actions that nourish our planet Earth: The first initiative that was born out of this, is the Earth Dinner Movement:



The Earth Dinner Movement invites to investigate and inquire about one's personal consumption habits. On this journey of discoveries, quite many people find out relatively quickly that they quite frequently consume in a way that rather has a negative than a positive effect on themselves, on nature or on human beings in other parts of the world.

Out of this Action of recognition, the Earth Dinner Movement invites to leave out these kinds of actions of consumption and to dedicate the value of one act of consumption every week to the project of the week. What happens is that we rededicate the value of unnecessary or unsustainable acts of consumptions so that it now can be used for projects that actually create, sustain and support life on this planet: projects that change the world in a positive way through sustainable actions and initiatives. We invert the knife of unconscious consumption and transform it into seeds of solidarity:

Every single week of the year one has the opportunity of exploring and rededicating one's acts of consumption. It's especially the small every day life decisions that can change the world when many people take them. (Imagine 500 people rededicating the value of an unsustainable act of consumption every week with an average of 5 Euros. Every week a precious project could be supported with 2500 Euros.) I personally have found out that my body and my mind feel a lot fresher and more awake when I leave out dinner at least once a week. The money is there and every week I send the money I would have spent on this dinner to the project of the week on the earth dinner platform. (www.earth-dinner.org) Some people leave out an Uber ride, a sweet, a car ride, they buy less clothes, there are no limits to your imagination.

Changing the world by changing ourselves

Many of us have the deep wish that things and circumstances in the outside world may change. The Earth Dinner Movement invites us to question our consumption habits and to redistribute money this way and nourish sustainable projects and initiatives all over the world. We empower ourselves to change the world. Of course, we have the wish that the wealthiest nations may cancel all the debts of the poorest nations, that they may stop exploiting them by charging huge interest payments for credits. (Especially knowing that a big part of the wealthiest nations' wealth was created through war, colonialism and imperialism.) But before this happens, we as individuals and as a community of compassionate human beings can already create consciousness in the direction of more possibilities in poorer regions of the world and for more humanity and a healthier planet.

Cycle of seven topics for seven weeks

Worldwide, we support projects that fit in an ever turning seven week cycle that deal with the following topics:

week 1: Seed Freedom

seed banks / food sovereignty

week 2: Sustainable Agriculture

sustainable organic agriculture

week 3: Protecting Life in Nature

week 4: The empowered woman

week 5: Children with a future

week 6: Holistic health prevention

week 7: Letting the heart speak



reforestation, indigenous people, water, fauna

support for women/ sustainable income

education / arts and creativity

mental, physical, spiritual

punctual support, for example for a family

Seed Freedom is the root of the food we eat. Only when there is free access to gmo free seeds, our farmers can nourish us in a self-determined, healthy and independent way. Every single initiative that supports seed freedom is necessary at this moment!

Sustainable agriculture takes into account its effects on mother earth. Agricultural systems that only pursue a maximum profit tend to ignore its long term effects and to destroy fertile earth and the drinking water in the long run.

What would life on earth be like without our **rain forests**, without flowing **waters**, without all the **animals** that keep up the equilibrium of life on this planet and that pollinate the plants? Who would take care of our rain forests if it weren't for the **indigenous people** who've been living in harmony with nature for millenia?

How much longer are women going to be suppressed by men in many parts of the world? Millions of **women** are **empowering themselves** and thousands of men are supporting them!

Who's going to create our societies in the future? Our **children**. Do we want that it to be created by human beings that have grown up with scarcity and fear or do we want it to be created by beings that have had a childhood of **freedom, creativity and solidarity**?

Our health is an immeasurable good. It's a wonderful idea to honor and care for it before it starts giving problems. Today we are more and more aware of the fact that health isn't a purely **physical** matter, but that it actually also includes **mental and emotional health**.

Every 7th week we support human beings or projects that need support for any kind of sustainable initiative. This allows us to be flexible and to also give **punctual support** spontaneously.

Numbers, donations, participants

100 percent of the money that is donated for the project of the week or for the project of the month is collectively passed on to the project of the week and the project of the month. All of the work done by the Association Seeds of Solidarity is based on voluntary work.

The costs of maintaining the work (bank account fee, webpage, flyers, designs etc.) are paid through membership fees (people who decide to become members of the association and to also support it through a yearly membership fee) and through donations that are explicitly made for the support of the work of the association.

Examples of what is possible with our reallocated financial resources:

Desert gardens (Entwicklungshilfeclub):
purchasing tools and the work that is necessary for 20 m2 of agricultural area in the desert require 47,60 Euros

Knowledge that cures:

A month of training and salary of a health assistant with focus on knowledge of traditional herbs in remote areas of Guatemala can be financed with 17 Euros.

Electrical mill in Venezuela:

A mill was purchased for 150 dollars. The Earth Dinner Movement was able to pay 95 of these 150 dollars. Now this family is grinding bananas and yuccas and even selling the surplus on the local market.

Electrical mill in the Andes of Venezuela

Andres and Mariana used to grind cooking bananas and yucca with a handmill. They had the wish to buy an electrical mill in order to produce more in these difficult times in Venezuela. In order to use the flour for themselves and to sell the surplus on the local market.



By now, they are generating some money doing this. This year the access to flour has been difficult and especially expensive for the common people in Venezuela. Andres' and Mariana's idea of making flour out of banana and yucca is a wonderful idea since they grow very easily in this part of Venezuela. This way, even in times of crisis people can have bread, soup etc. with this flour.

The electrical mill cost 150 dollars and the Earth Dinner Movement was able to support 95 dollars.

Guarani Kaiowa – Praying houses in Brasil

This indigenous tribe in Brasil is having severe difficulties in not being thrown out of their lands. They have been trying to reoccupy parts of their original lands. Many of them are now barren because of agrottoxicals that have been used for monocultures on many of these lands. In order to root themselves more and more they have started building Praying houses in all of the little villages they have constructed. These will serve as a cultural and spiritual centers.

The participants of the Earth Dinner movement have been helping to finance natural construction materials, transportation costs since the kind of straw that they use as a roof has to be transported from far away in some cases. The Praying houses will be a help for the Guarani-Kaiowa to stay connected with their culture and to stay connected and in solidarity with each other.

A group of Venezuelan women was supported by buying them a Fetal Doppler ultrasound machine for hearing the heart beat of little babies before they're born and ultra sound gels. We also sent them 65 dollars in order for them to buy necessary utensils like scissors etc.

These very motivated women are right now offering a weekly circle for pregnant women and their partners in the city of Merida, Venezuela. There they are accompanying their physical and emotional processes.

Support through the Earth Dinner Movement:

Fetal Doppler (65 dollars), Gel (9 dollars), 63 dollars for buying necessary utensils



Gardens in the desert (Burkina Faso)

Our project partner, the Entwicklungshilfeclub describes this projects in the following way: “The harvests haven't been sufficient for small farming families in the dry northeast of Burkina Faso for years now. The Burkinabe people have always been able deal with the weather cycles in the savanna. Decreasing rainfalls and increasing heat have been prolonging the already very long periods of drought. The consequence is a lack of water. Without water nothing can grow, nothing can be harvested. People starve. Through the construction of an artificial oasis – a so called Bouli – a piece of desert land can be turned into gardens. Around a water basin, vegetable gardens are created and a forest belt is planted.



These gardens in the desert secure food for the farming families in the period of drought and help them to make a little bit of money by selling a part of their harvest.



Important events in 2019

More than thirty people gathered for this celebration and listened to the presentations by Heinz Richter (Entwicklungshilfeclub), by Manuel Galvan (Inrico Graz) and by Cornelia Sterner, Eva Sauer and Philipp Sudi (Seeds of Solidarity)!

Afterwards there was food, drinks and interesting conversations. People were able to get to know the Earth Dinner Movement closely and to ask questions.

At the end there was a concert by Philipp Ham Kuman and Pablito Bertone with smooth sounds and inspiring lyrics.

All in all, an inspiring celebration where we were able to also raise some money for the costs of the work of the association and where some beautiful connections were established!
